About the workshop:

Oral motor impairment presents a variety of challenges for both the individual affected, and for the care team providing intervention. The assessment & intervention protocol developed by Beckman is based on clinically defined functional parameters of minimal competence, not requiring the cognitive participation of the individual, and useful with a wide range of ages (birth to geriatric) and diagnostic categories.

In this two-days, hands-on intensive course, participants will actively participate in hands-on practice over 50 specific intervention strategies for improving facial muscle function, use of compensatory handling techniques for the concerns: e.g. tonic bite, tonic bite on a utensil, slow oral transit, tongue thrust, cough, gag and vomit etc.

The participants will complete an oral motor protocol with each other, analyze the results, and discuss data tracking.

Additional topics of discussion relating to oral feeding will be discussed, e.g. diet texture progression, tube to oral issues, adaptive mealtime utensils, oral hygiene issues, medication administration issues, oral function for individuals with tracheotomy, facilitating improved articulation through oral motor techniques, research issues, videofluoroscopy issues for motorically involved individuals.
